

Full-time Example

Trinity Anglican School Early Learning Centre currently offers a full-time (10-day fortnight) kindergarten program. The diagram below is for illustration purposes of a full-time example only.

The Queensland Government Free Kindy initiative provides 15 hours per week for free to eligible children, and all additional hours that form part of your program sit outside of this initiative (however, depending on your eligibility, they may be subsidised by CCS).

TAS charges a daily rate for the number of days that your child attends the program. To calculate what is payable by parents each day, we take the daily rate, apply the CCS percentage and CCS withholding percentage, and then deduct the 15 free hours.



-  **Queensland Government funding**
Applies to all children enrolled in an approved Kindy and who are at least 4 years old by 30 June in the year they are registered.
-  **Australian Government Childcare Subsidy (CCS) may apply if eligible.**
