Outdoor Recreation Space

Landscaped areas for relaxation and social connection.

Tuckshop

Providing both school lunches and catering for functions.

Amenities

Modern and comfortable facilities.



Proposed Timeline

Early works are expected to commence in December 2025, with main construction beginning in early - mid 2026 and continuing for approximately 12 months. We look forward to welcoming the school community into The Trinity Centre in 2027.

In preparation for construction, we are finalising new entrances to the Reception and Early Learning Centre, scheduled for completion ahead of the 2026 school year in January.

The project will involve clearing trees from the new building site, demolishing the existing chapel, and constructing the new facility. The building will feature a slab-on-platform design, tilt-panel construction, and a structural steel framework, delivering a durable and contemporary space that will serve our community for many years to come.

A note from the Principal

I am delighted to share the exciting news of our plans to construct The Trinity Centre at the TAS Kewarra Beach Campus. As the first project from our new Masterplan, this landmark facility has been thoughtfully designed to meet the needs of our students and provide a vibrant gathering place for our entire school community.

Breaking ground in December 2025 and scheduled to open in 2027, The Trinity Centre will feature air-conditioned seating for 450–500 people, creating a comfortable and versatile venue for assemblies, performances, and major school events. A new tuckshop will offer catering for school lunches and community functions, while purpose-built music ensemble and practice rooms will inspire creativity, artistic expression, and musical excellence. Students and staff will also enjoy a landscaped outdoor space, providing a welcoming area for relaxation, connection, and celebration.

This project is an investment in our students' learning, wellbeing, and sense of belonging. It reflects our commitment to providing facilities that support academic, cultural, artistic, and community life at TAS. I look forward to watching The Trinity Centre come to life at the Kewarra Beach Campus and to the opportunities it will create for generations of students to come.


